<u>New Lectionaries</u> At the start of Advent this year a new Lectionary with new biblical translations will become mandatory for all Catholic parishes and Mass centres in England, Wales and Scotland. The changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, biblical scholarship, and to provide a text for use in liturgical setting. These books must be of good quality, a high standard and durable as they contain the Word of God and will be used at every Mass.

The new Lectionaries have cost ± 335.75 for Efford, ± 824.50 for Plympton and ± 590.75 for Ivybridge. The Catholic Women's League has generously funded the Ivybridge Lectionaries – see note of thanks below.
